

# “The Servant of All”

## Mark 1:1-31

Sunday, January 14, 2024

### 1. HIS WORK is to Fulfill Prophecy (1-8)

### 2. HIS WORK is to Establish Righteousness (9-11)

A. (Is 11:1-2) “There shall come forth a Rod from the stem of Jesse, And a Branch shall grow out of his roots. The Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him, The Spirit of wisdom and understanding, The Spirit of counsel and might, The Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord.” NKJV

B. (Mt 3:13-15) “Then Jesus came from Galilee to John at the Jordan to be baptized by him. And John tried to prevent Him, saying, “I need to be baptized by You, and are You coming to me?” But Jesus answered and said to him, “Permit it to be so now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness.” Then he allowed Him.” NKJV

C. (2 Co 5:21) “For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.” NKJV

### 3. HIS WORK is to Overcome Sin (12-13)

A. (Ro 3:23) “for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,” NKJV

B. (Heb 4:15) “For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin.” NKJV

C. (Eph 2:8-9) “<sup>8</sup> For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, <sup>9</sup> not of works, lest anyone should boast.” NKJV

D. (Ro 8:1-2) “<sup>1</sup> There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. <sup>2</sup> For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.” NKJV

### 4. HIS WORK is to Establish the Kingdom (14-15)

A. Repentance Basic Explanation: Turn FROM what shouldn’t be in your mind, your heart, on your calendar, in your life and turn TO what the Lord wants to be in your mind, your heart, on your calendar, and in your life

### 5. HIS WORKERS are Called to Follow Him (16-20)

A. (1 Ti 4:7-8) “<sup>7</sup> ...exercise yourself toward godliness. <sup>8</sup> For bodily exercise profits a little, but godliness is profitable for all things, having promise of the life that now is and of that which is to come.” NKJV

B. (Lk 14:26) “If anyone comes to Me and does not hate his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, yes, and his own life also, he cannot be My disciple.” NKJV

C. (Mt 19:29) “And everyone who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or lands, for My name’s sake, shall receive a hundredfold, and inherit eternal life.” NKJV

A. (Col 3:23-24) “<sup>23</sup> And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men, <sup>24</sup> knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ.” NKJV
