1. Passions that War (1-3)

- A. (Pr 14:30) says: "A sound heart is life to the body, but envy is rottenness to the bones." NKJV
- B. (Mt 6:33), "But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you" NKJV

2. Partnerships that Wreck (4-6)

- A. (Eph 6:12) "For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places." NKJV
- B. (Mt 6:24) "No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon." NKJV

3. Practices that Restore (7-10)

- A. (2 Co 7:10) "For godly sorrow produces repentance leading to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death." NKJV
- B. (Lk 14:11) "For whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted."
