1. Strength Shown in Waiting (7-8)

- A. (Ec 3:11) "He has made everything beautiful in its time. Also He has put eternity in their hearts, except that no one can find out the work that God does from beginning to end." NKJV
- B. (Ga 6:9) "And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart." NKJV

2. Strength Shown in Withstanding (9-11)

- A. (Ro 5:3-4) "³ And not only that, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance; ⁴ and perseverance, character; and character, hope." NKJV

3. Strength Shown in Witnessing (12)

- A. (Mt 5:37) "But let your 'Yes' be 'Yes,' and your 'No,' 'No.' For whatever is more than these is from the evil one." NKJV
- B. (Pr 12:22) "Lying lips are an abomination to the LORD, But those who deal truthfully are His delight." NKJV
