 - She is in the hospital in Carrollton. She hasn't been able to eat hardly anything and can't keep down what she does eat. She is on IVs to get fluids and needed medication.
- Tracy Miles Niece - Update as of Sept. 29th - Delilah went to the doctor today and she has CML. It is a milder form of leukemia and she can be treated with medicine by the Drs in Jonesboro. Darcy (Tracy's sister) said thank you for the continued prayers.
