## VBS MISSION PROJECT: Helping Our Neighbors!

This year, our VBS is partnering with Community Outreach Ministries (COM) right here in Bolivar. Instead of our traditional coin offering, we are hosting a "Stock the Shelves" Food Drive!

### How it works

From Sunday through Thursday, kids are invited to bring in non-perishable food items (canned goods, boxed pasta, cereal, etc.). We will have a "collection wagon" at our opening rally each night for the kids to see the big impact they are making together.
