 - **A Long-Awaited Meal: For the first time in days, Laura is finally allowed to eat and drink! Even though it is a restricted liquid diet, she is thrilled to have some food!**
 - **New Room: She has officially been moved out of the PCU and into Med-Surg Room 122.**
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- **Jeff Ferguson - As of Friday, February 20 - Praise report: Jeff Ferguson is getting to go home today. He will still need lots of help and his son and wife are coming in to help Cindy (his wife) take care of him. Thank everyone for their prayers!**
 - He is the pastor at First Baptist Church Lowry City. He had heart surgery and he woke up earlier confused. They are doing a CT and other evaluations.
