On a very bright note, we are celebrating a huge milestone: Laura is officially back on solid foods! This is such a wonderful sign of progress for her digestive system. Additionally, the medical team is hopeful that her final drain can be removed as early as tomorrow, which would be another significant step toward healing.**

However, we are also facing some new hurdles that require our urgent prayers. A new infection has been detected, and while the doctors are currently using broad-spectrum antibiotics to treat it, they are still working to identify exactly what it is. They hope to have more specific results by tomorrow to target the treatment more effectively. Furthermore, Laura is still struggling with a persistent cough that hasn't shown much improvement, which is quite draining for her. Please join us in praying that the antibiotics work quickly, that the doctors gain total clarity on this new infection, and that her lungs would finally find relief from the coughing. We continue to lift up Laura and Michael for strength and endurance through these ups and downs.
