- **Drainage Issues: During a dressing change this morning, the doctor was concerned with the type of drainage he saw. As a result, her liquid diet has been stopped, and she is back on ice chips only.**
- **Potential Transfer: The medical team is monitoring her closely to see if additional surgery is required. If her condition doesn't improve here, there is a possibility she will be transferred to a larger facility in Springfield or Kansas City for specialized surgical care.**
- **Timeline: It now looks like her hospital stay could extend at least another two weeks.**
