While she had a brief moment of feeling better, her condition slowly declined over the weekend, leading to her readmission. The doctors have confirmed that she is dealing with another internal infection and fluid drainage. As a result, she is scheduled for surgery later today so the medical team can clean out the infection, place a new drainage tube, and get a clearer picture of why this is recurring.**

Please join us in praying for the surgeons today—that they would find the root cause of these infections once and for all.
