 - **The Surgery Outcome**
 - **The surgeon was able to thoroughly clean out the infection and successfully placed two drain lines. These are connected to a vacuum system designed to keep the area clear so her intestines can heal properly. While they expect a hospital stay of about two weeks to ensure everything stays on track, she has been moved from the ICU to PCU Room 2.**
 - **Today's Progress**
 - **The doctor visited this morning and shared that she is doing better than expected. In fact, the goal for today is to get her up and walking! While they are cautious, they are incredibly encouraged by this quick turn toward progress.**
