Our Weekly Edification

London Baptist Confession 10.1

1. God Effectually Calls the Elect

In his appointed and decided time, God effectually calls those whom he has predestined to life ¹ out of their natural state of sin and death to grace and salvation through Jesus Christ. He effectually calls them through his Word and Spirit. ² He enlightens their minds spiritually and savingly so they can understand the things of God. ³ He takes away their heart of stone and gives them a heart of flesh. 4 He renews their wills, and by his almighty power he gives them a desire to do things that are good. He effectually draws them to Jesus Christ, ⁵ so that they come freely, since by his grace, he has caused them to be willing to come. ⁶
