If you believe in Jesus, but are not connected to His church in the above ways; or if you are not sure whether you have been saved by God's grace through faith in Jesus Christ alone; then please refrain from partaking of the elements. If you have questions about our communion practice or about your relationship to Christ's church, please speak with the elders after worship.

Our Weekly Edification

London Baptist Confession 9.4

4. Jesus' Atoning Work -Jesus willingly accepted this office. ²¹ In order to fulfill it, he was born under the law. ²² He perfectly fulfilled the law and suffered the punishment we deserved, which we should have endured and suffered. ²³ He was made sin and a curse for us. ²⁴ He endured extremely serious sorrows in his soul and extremely painful sufferings in his body. ²⁵ He was crucified and died, and remained in a state of death, but his body did not decay. ²⁶ On the third day, he rose from the dead ²⁷ with the same body in which he suffered. ²⁸ In this body, he also ascended into heaven, ²⁹ where he sits at the right hand of his Father and intercedes. ³⁰ He will return to judge humanity and angels at the end of the age. ³¹
