- 2. *I have been baptized in a local church* into the Name of the Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit.
- 3. *I am not presently under church discipline*; wherein governing elders have removed you from the receiving of the table and the fellowship of the saints because of unrepentant sin.

If you believe in Jesus, but are not connected to His church in the above ways; or if you are not sure whether you have been saved by God's grace through faith in Jesus Christ alone; then please refrain from partaking of the elements. If you have questions about our communion practice or about your relationship to Christ's church, please speak with the elders after worship.

London Baptist Confession 9.3

- 3. Jesus Is Mediator The Lord Jesus, as someone whose human nature was in this way united with his divine nature (the person of the Son), was sanctified and anointed with the Holy Spirit beyond measure. 13 He had in himself all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. 14 It pleased the Father that all fullness would dwell in him, 15 so that, as someone who was holy, harmless, undefiled, 16 and full of grace and truth, 17 he would be fully qualified to fulfill the office of mediator and guarantor. 18 He did not take this office upon himself, but rather was called to it by his father, 19 who also put all power and judgment into his hand and commanded him to execute this power and judgment. ²⁰
