### **A renewed mind.**

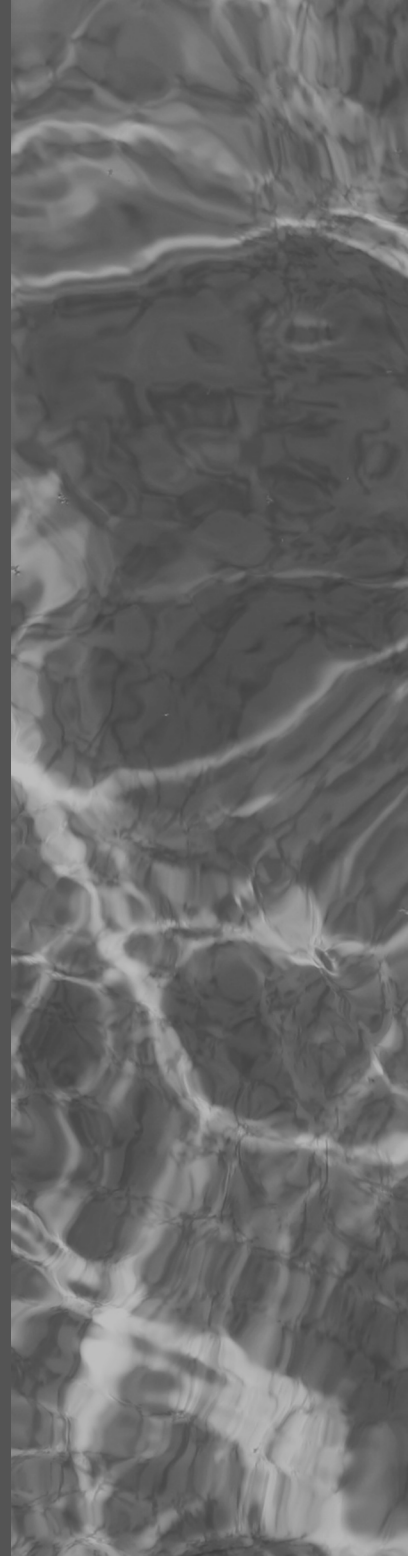
A relationship with Jesus, coupled with the Word of God will produce a renewed mind.

## **DAILY CHALLENGE**

Today challenge yourself to stay off of social media and ask God how he feels about our country. Seek His heart.

**DAILY CHALLENGE**

Take sometime for self-reflection on how well you have loved lately. Write down ways that you can continue to love well or how you can love better.

**PRAYER**

Dear Jesus, you have called us to love our neighbors. Help us to love all the people you have created and love them well. In Jesus' name I pray, Amen!

What is the commandment we have from God? And, most importantly, why do you think God gave us this command?

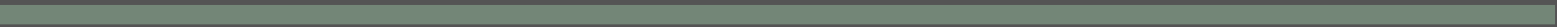
What to do?
