Bible Study Guide: Walking Faithfully with God

Trusting the Process and Walking Faithfully with God

Objective: To understand the importance of faithfulness in our walk with God, inspired by the life of Enoch, and to encourage participants to trust God's process in their lives.

Key Scripture:

- Genesis 5:21-24
- Revelation 2:10
- Deuteronomy 7:9
- Hebrews 13:8

Opening Prayer:

Begin with a prayer asking for God's guidance and wisdom as you study His Word together.

Introduction (10 minutes):

- Briefly summarize the sermon, highlighting the key points about Enoch's faithfulness and God's promise to never leave us.
- Discuss the concept of "trusting the process" as mentioned in the sermon.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Understanding Enoch's Walk with God (15 minutes):
 - Read Genesis 5:21-24. What does it mean that Enoch "walked faithfully with God"?
 - How can we apply Enoch's example of faithfulness in our daily lives?
- 2. Trusting God's Process (15 minutes):
- Reflect on the statement from the sermon: "Things may not always pan out the way that you think they should, but if you just trust the process."
 - Share personal experiences where trusting God's process led to unexpected blessings.
- 3. Faithfulness in Trials (15 minutes):
 - Read Revelation 2:10. What does it mean to be "faithful unto death"?
 - Discuss how trials and tribulations can strengthen our faith.

- 4. God's Unchanging Nature (15 minutes):
- Read Hebrews 13:8. How does knowing that Jesus is the same yesterday, today, and forever provide comfort in our walk with God?
 - Discuss how God's faithfulness is evident in your life.
- 5. Living Out Faithfulness (15 minutes):
 - Read Deuteronomy 7:9. How can we demonstrate our love for God through faithfulness?
 - What practical steps can we take to remain faithful in our relationship with God and others?

Activity: Personal Reflection and Commitment (10 minutes)

- Encourage participants to write down one area in their life where they need to trust God's process more fully.
- Ask them to commit to one action step they will take this week to walk more faithfully with God.

Closing Prayer:

Conclude with a prayer, thanking God for His faithfulness and asking for strength to remain faithful in our walk with Him.

Optional: Worship Song

- Consider ending the session with a worship song that reflects the theme of faithfulness, such as "Great is Thy Faithfulness" or "Faithful to the End."
