



#### **CONFESSION OF FAITH\***

Apostles' Creed

All: I believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth.

I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, and born of the virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From there He will come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

## CONFESSION OF SIN

Leader: My soul also is greatly troubled; But You, O LORD -- how long?

All: Return, O LORD, deliver me! Oh, save me for Your mercies' sake!

Leader: For in death *there is* no remembrance of You; in the grave who will give You thanks?

All: I am weary with my groaning; All night I make my bed swim; I drench my couch with my tears.

Leader: My eye wastes away because of grief; It grows old because of all my enemies.

All: Depart from me, all you workers of iniquity; For the LORD has heard the voice of my weeping.

Leader: The LORD has heard my supplication; The LORD will receive my prayer.

All: Let all my enemies be ashamed and greatly troubled; Let them turn back and be ashamed suddenly.

#### GOSPEL READING

Matthew 20:1-16

"For the kingdom of heaven is like a landowner who went out early in the morning to hire laborers for his vineyard. <sup>2</sup>"Now when he had agreed with the laborers for a denarius a day, he sent them into his vineyard. 3"And he went out about the third hour and saw others standing idle in the marketplace, 4" and said to them, 'You also go into the vineyard, and whatever is right I will give you.' So they went. 5"Again he went out about the sixth and the ninth hour, and did likewise. 6"And about the eleventh hour he went out and found others standing idle, and said to them, 'Why have you been standing here idle all day?' 7"They said to him, 'Because no one hired us.' He said to them, 'You also go into the vineyard, and whatever is right you will receive.' 8"So when evening had come, the owner of the vineyard said to his steward, 'Call the laborers and give them their wages, beginning with the last to the first.' 9"And when those came who were hired about the eleventh hour, they each received a denarius. 10"But when the first came, they supposed that they would receive more; and they likewise received each a denarius. <sup>11</sup>"And when they had received it, they complained against the landowner, <sup>12</sup>"saying, 'These last men have worked only one hour, and you made them equal to us who have borne the burden and the heat of the day.' 13"But he answered one of them and said, 'Friend, I am doing you no wrong. Did you not agree with me for a denarius? 14'Take what is yours and go your way. I wish to give to this last man the same as to you. 15 Is it not lawful for me to do what I wish with my own things? Or is your eye evil because I am good?' 16"So the last will be first, and the first last. For many are called, but few chosen."

## **NEW TESTAMENT READING**

Romans 2:17-29

Indeed you are called a Jew, and rest on the law, and make your boast in God, <sup>18</sup> and know *His* will, and approve the things that are excellent, being instructed out of the law, <sup>19</sup> and are

confident that you yourself are a guide to the blind, a light to those who are in darkness, <sup>20</sup>an instructor of the foolish, a teacher of babes, having the form of knowledge and truth in the law. <sup>21</sup>You, therefore, who teach another, do you not teach yourself? You who preach that a man should not steal, do you steal? <sup>22</sup>You who say, "Do not commit adultery," do you commit adultery? You who abhor idols, do you rob temples? <sup>23</sup>You who make your boast in the law, do you dishonor God through breaking the law? <sup>24</sup>For "the name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles because of you," as it is written. <sup>25</sup>For circumcision is indeed profitable if you keep the law; but if you are a breaker of the law, your circumcision has become uncircumcision. <sup>26</sup>Therefore, if an uncircumcised man keeps the righteous requirements of the law, will not his uncircumcision be counted as circumcision? <sup>27</sup>And will not the physically uncircumcised, if he fulfills the law, judge you who, *even* with *your* written *code* and circumcision, *are* a transgressor of the law? <sup>28</sup>For he is not a Jew who *is one* outwardly, nor *is* circumcision that which *is* outward in the flesh; <sup>29</sup>but *he is* a Jew who *is one* inwardly; and circumcision *is that* of the heart, in the Spirit, not in the letter; whose praise *is* not from men but from God.

## Genesis 42:18-24 "Some Ground Breaking to be Done" Pastor Marc Miller

- Then Joseph said to them the third day, "Do this and live, for I fear God:
- "If you *are* honest *men,* let one of your brothers be confined to your prison house; but you, go and carry grain for the famine of your houses.

- <sup>20</sup> "And bring your youngest brother to me; so your words will be verified, and you shall not die." And they did so.
- Then they said to one another, "We *are* truly guilty concerning our brother, for we saw the anguish of his soul when he pleaded with us, and we would not hear; therefore this distress has come upon us."
- And Reuben answered them, saying, "Did I not speak to you, saying, 'Do not sin against the boy'; and you would not listen? Therefore behold, his blood is now required of us."
- <sup>23</sup> But they did not know that Joseph understood *them,* for he spoke to them through an interpreter.
- And he turned himself away from them and wept. Then he returned to them again, and talked with them. And he took Simeon from them and bound him before their eyes.

- The session has determined that it is time to open nominations for the office of Ruling Elder and to receive nominations from the congregation. Nominations are to be received from communicate members of the church.
  - Prospective officers must be an active male member of West Erie PCA who meet the qualifications as found in 1 Timothy 3 and Titus 1.
    - 1 Timothy 3:2-7 <sup>2</sup>A bishop (elder) then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, temperate, sober-minded, of good behavior, hospitable, able to teach; <sup>3</sup>not given to wine, not violent, not greedy for money, but gentle, not quarrelsome, not covetous; <sup>4</sup>one who rules his own house well, having *his* children in submission with all reverence <sup>5</sup>(for if a man does not know how to rule his own house, how will he take care of the church of God?); <sup>6</sup> not a novice, lest being puffed up with pride he fall into the *same* condemnation as the devil. <sup>7</sup>Moreover he must have a good testimony among those who are outside, lest he fall into reproach and the snare of the devil.

- If you believe there are men who are members of the congregation that may be qualified for this office please ask them first, and if they are willing to be nominated, inform the elders of the church.
- After a nomination period, a time of training will begin, followed by a called congregational meeting to elect those the session has approved.
- If you have any questions, please talk to Pastor Miller or one of the elders of the church.

#### Who Should take Communion?

The question of who is eligible to receive communion is one of vital importance. In order to draw our minds towards examining ourselves in accordance with the Apostle Paul's exhortation to the church in Corinth, the Session of West Erie Presbyterian Church in America encourages all in attendance today to consider the following questions:

- Do you believe that Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died for your sins and rose again bodily from the dead?
- Do you trust in the Lord Jesus Christ alone for your salvation?
- o Have you been baptized?
- Are you a communicate member in good standing of a Bible-believing, gospel proclaiming church?
- Are you pursuing a life of obedience by forsaking sin and striving, by grace and help of the Holy Spirit, to glorify God with your entire life?

If you can answer "Yes" to each of these questions, then the Session of West Erie Presbyterian Church in America welcomes and invites you to partake of the Lord's Supper with us today.

If however, you cannot answer "Yes" to each of these questions – or if you are not sure – then we request that you refrain from partaking at this time. We encourage you to take this time to consider your own personal need for Christ, His abundant provision for the salvation of sinners, as well of the biblical requirement to join a local body of believers in humble submission to Christ's provision of elders and overseers. After the service, please come speak with a member of the Session to discuss the steps necessary to enable you to openly enjoy Communion with Christ and his people through the sacrament of the Lord's Supper.
