GOSPEL READING

Matthew 12:22-37

"Then one was brought to Him who was demon-possessed, blind and mute; and He healed him, so that the blind and mute man both spoke and saw. ²³And all the multitudes were amazed and said, "Could this be the Son of David?" ²⁴Now when the Pharisees heard *it* they said, "This *fellow* does not cast out demons except by Beelzebub, the ruler of the demons." ²⁵But Jesus knew their thoughts, and said to them: "Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation, and every city or house divided against itself will not stand. ²⁶If Satan casts out Satan, he is divided against himself. How then will his kingdom stand? ²⁷And if I cast out demons by Beelzebub, by whom do your sons cast *them* out? Therefore they shall be your judges. ²⁸But if I cast out demons by the Spirit of God, surely the kingdom of God has come upon you. ²⁹Or how can one enter a strong man's house and plunder his goods, unless he first binds the strong man? And then he will plunder his house. ³⁰He who is not with Me is against Me, and he who does not gather with Me scatters abroad. ³¹Therefore I say to you, every sin and blasphemy will be forgiven men, but the blasphemy *against* the Spirit will not be forgiven men. ³²Anyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man, it will be forgiven him; but whoever speaks against the Holy Spirit, it will not be forgiven him, either in this age or in the *age* to come. ³³ Either make the tree good and its fruit good, or else make the tree bad and its fruit bad; for a tree is known by *its* fruit. ³⁴Brood of vipers! How can you, being evil, speak good things? For out of

the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks. ³⁵"A good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth good things, and an evil man out of the evil treasure brings forth evil things. ³⁶"But I say to you that for every idle word men may speak, they will give account of it in the day of judgment. ³⁷"For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned.

NEW TESTAMENT READING

Acts 20:17-38

From Miletus he sent to Ephesus and called for the elders of the church. ¹⁸And when they had come to him, he said to them: "You know, from the first day that I came to Asia, in what manner I always lived among you, ¹⁹"serving the Lord with all humility, with many tears and trials which happened to me by the plotting of the Jews; ²⁰"how I kept back nothing that was helpful, but proclaimed it to you, and taught you publicly and from house to house, ²¹"testifying to Jews, and also to Greeks, repentance toward God and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ. ²²"And see, now I go bound in the spirit to Jerusalem, not knowing the things that will happen to me there, ²³"except that the Holy Spirit testifies in every city, saying that chains and tribulations await me. ²⁴"But none of these things move me; nor do I count my life dear to myself, so that I may finish my race with joy, and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God. ²⁵"And indeed, now I know that you all, among whom I have gone preaching the kingdom of God, will see my face no more. ²⁶"Therefore I testify to you this day that I *am* innocent of the blood of all *men*. ²⁷"For I have not shunned to declare to you the whole counsel of God. ²⁸"Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood. ²⁹"For I know this, that after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock. ³⁰"Also from among yourselves men will rise up, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after themselves. ³¹"Therefore watch, and remember that for three years I did not cease to warn everyone night and day with tears. ³²"So now, brethren, I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified. ³³"I have coveted no one's silver or gold or apparel. ³⁴"Yes, you yourselves know that these hands have provided for my necessities, and for those who were with me. ³⁵"I have shown you in every way, by laboring like this, that you must support the weak. And remember the words of the Lord Jesus, that He said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.' " ³⁶And when he had said these things, he knelt down and prayed with them all. ³⁷Then they all wept freely, and fell on Paul's neck and kissed him, ³⁸sorrowing most of all for the words which he spoke, that they would see his face no more. And they accompanied him to the ship.

SERMON

Genesis 39:1-10 ***"The Lord was With Joseph-Part 1"*** Pastor Marc Miller

- ¹ Now Joseph had been taken down to Egypt. And Potiphar, an officer of Pharaoh, captain of the guard, an Egyptian, bought him from the Ishmaelites who had taken him down there.
- ² The LORD was with Joseph, and he was a successful man; and he was in the house of his master the Egyptian.
- ³ And his master saw that the LORD *was* with him and that the LORD made all he did to prosper in his hand.
- ⁴ So Joseph found favor in his sight, and served him. Then he made him overseer of his house, and all *that* he had he put under his authority.
- ⁵ So it was, from the time *that* he had made him overseer of his house and all that he had, that the LORD blessed the Egyptian's house for Joseph's sake; and the blessing of the LORD was on all that he had in the house and in the field.
- ⁶ Thus he left all that he had in Joseph's hand, and he did not know what he had except for the bread which he ate. Now Joseph was handsome in form and appearance.
- ⁷ And it came to pass after these things that his master's wife cast longing eyes on Joseph, and she said, "Lie with me."

- 8 But he refused and said to his master's wife, "Look, my master does not know what *is* with me in the house, and he has committed all that he has to my hand.
- 9 "*There is* no one greater in this house than I, nor has he kept back anything from me but you, because you *are* his wife. How then can I do this great wickedness, and sin against God?"
- 10 So it was, as she spoke to Joseph day by day, that he did not heed her, to lie with her *or* to be with her.
