READING

1st Peter 2:2-10

The lesson is from the first letter of Peter, chapter two, verses two through ten. Peter writes:

² Like newborn infants, long for the pure, spiritual milk, so that by it you may grow into salvation— ³ if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is good. ⁴ Come to Him, a living stone, though rejected by mortals yet chosen and precious in God's sight, and ⁵ like living stones let yourselves be built into a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. ⁶ For it stands in scripture: "See, I am laying in Zion a stone, a cornerstone chosen and precious, and whoever believes in Him will not be put to shame."

⁷This honor, then, is for you who believe, but for those who do not believe, "The stone that the builders rejected has become the very head of the corner," ⁸ and "A stone that makes them stumble and a rock that makes them fall." They stumble because they disobey the word, as they were destined to do.

⁹ But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's own people, in order that you may proclaim the excellence of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light. ¹⁰ Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

GOSPEL

John 14:1-14

The Gospel reading is from John, chapter fourteen, verses one through fourteen.

Jesus proclaims:

"Do not let your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in Me. ² In My Father's house there are many dwelling places. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? ³ And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to Myself, so that where I am, there you may be also. ⁴ And you know the way to the place where I am going." ⁵ Thomas said to

Him, "Lord, we do not know where You are going. How can we know the way?" ⁶ Jesus said to him, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. ⁷ If you know Me, you will know My Father also. From now on you do know Him and have seen Him."

⁸ Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and we will be satisfied." ⁹ Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you all this time, Philip, and you still do not know Me? Whoever has seen Me has seen the Father. How can you say, 'Show us the Father'? ¹⁰ Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in Me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on My own, but the Father who dwells in Me does His works. ¹¹ Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father is in Me, but if you do not, then believe because of the works themselves. ¹² Very truly, I tell you, the one who believes in Me will also do the works that I do and, in fact, will do greater works than these, because I am going to the Father. ¹³ I will do whatever you ask in My Name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. ¹⁴ If in My Name you ask Me for anything, I will do it."
