READING

Romans 5:1-8

The lesson is from the letter of Paul to the Romans, chapter five, verses one through eight. Paul writes:

Therefore, since we are justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, ² through whom we have obtained access to this grace in which we stand, and we boast in our hope of sharing the glory of God. ³ And not only that, but we also boast in our afflictions, knowing that affliction produces endurance, ⁴ and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, ⁵ and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us.

⁶ For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. ⁷ Indeed, rarely will anyone die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person someone might actually dare to die. ⁸ But God proves His love for us in that while we still were sinners Christ died for us.

Matthew 9:35-38

The Gospel reading is from Matthew, chapter nine, verses thirty-five through thirty-eight.

Matthew writes:

Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and curing every disease and every sickness. ³⁶ When He saw the crowds, He had compassion for them because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. ³⁷ Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; ³⁸ therefore ask the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest."
