READING

Ephesians 2:1-10 The lesson is from the letter of Paul to the Ephesians, chapter two, verses one through ten. Paul writes:

You were dead through the trespasses and sins ² in which you once walked, following the course of this world, following the ruler of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work among those who are disobedient. ³ All of us once lived among them in the passions of our flesh, doing the will of flesh and senses, and we were by nature children of wrath, like everyone else, ⁴ but God, who is rich in mercy, out of the great love with which He loved us ⁵ even when we were dead through our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved—⁶ and raised us up with Him and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, ⁷ so that in the ages to come He might show the immeasurable riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. ⁸ For by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God—⁹ not the result of works, so that no one may boast. ¹⁰ For we are what He has made us, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we may walk in them.

GOSPEL

Matthew 9:9-17 The Gospel reading is from John, chapter nine, verses nine through seventeen. Jesus proclaims:

⁹ As Jesus was walking along, He saw a man called Matthew sitting at the taxcollection station, and He said to him, "Follow Me." And he got up and followed Him. ¹⁰ And as He sat at dinner in the house, many tax collectors and sinners came and were sitting with Jesus and His disciples. ¹¹ When the Pharisees saw this, they said to His disciples, "Why does your teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?"¹² But when He heard this, He said, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. ¹³ Go and learn what this means, 'I desire mercy, not sacrifice.' For I have not come to call the righteous but sinners." ¹⁴ Then the disciples of John came to Him, saying, "Why do we and the Pharisees fast often, but Your disciples do not fast?"¹⁵ And Jesus said to them, "The wedding attendants cannot mourn as long as the bridegroom is with them, can they? The days will come when the bridegroom is taken away from them, and then they will fast. ¹⁶ No one sews a piece of unshrunk cloth on an old cloak, for the patch pulls away from the cloak, and a worse tear is made. ¹⁷ Neither is new wine put into old wineskins; otherwise, the skins burst, and the wine is spilled, and the skins are ruined, but new wine is put into fresh wineskins, and so both are preserved."
