- P: Almighty God, to whom all hearts are open, all desires known, and from whom no secrets are hid: cleanse the thoughts of our hearts by the inspiration of your Holy Spirit, that we may perfectly love you and worthily magnify your holy name, through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- C: Amen.

- - The Gospel of Mark seems to end like a bad movie. It leaves us hanging, incomplete, literally in the middle of a sentence.
- It is up to the readers and hearers of this story to finish it by how they respond to it and live their lives.
- But that's exactly the problem: in our hands the story always seems to end miserably.
- Therefore, Jesus writes the rest of the story for us by keeping his promise and appearing "in Galilee."
- Where is "Galilee" for us? In the ordinary and mundane places of this world where God keeps his promises and we are loved.
- Therefore, trusting God's promise, it possible for us to write the rest of the Easter story and bring it to its completion in our ordinary lives "in Galilee."
