SERMON

Today's message will center on **Galatians 5:22-23**

22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, **23** gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

Matthew 22:35-40 **35** And one of them, a lawyer, asked him a question to test him.

36 "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?" **37** And he said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.

38 This is the great and first commandment. **39** And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. **40** On these two commandments depend all the Law and the Prophets."

1. Why does Paul call them the fruit (singular) of the spirit, instead of the fruits (plural)?
2. What two commandments does Jesus say fulfill the whole law?
