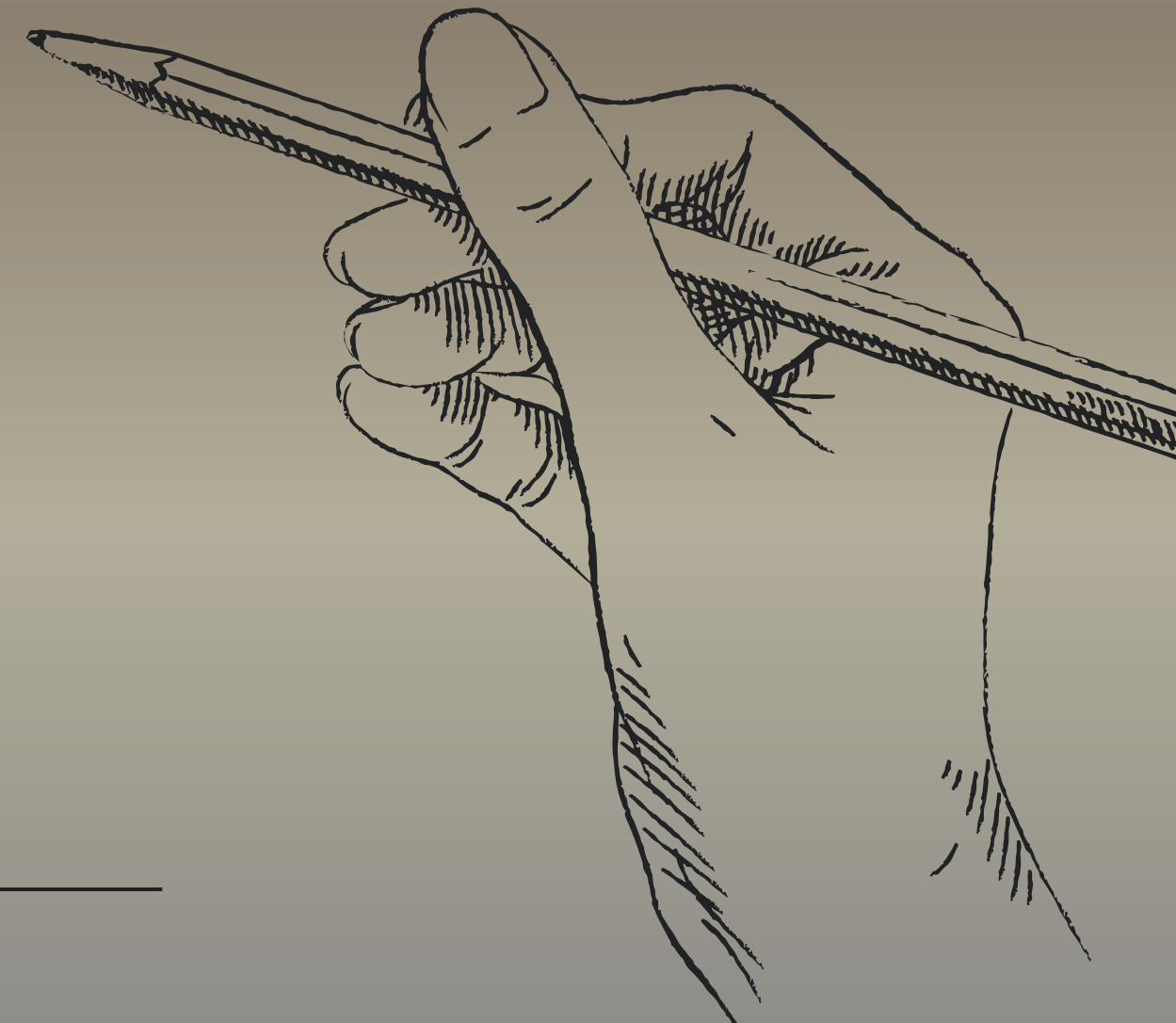
How does this story fit into the rest of “redemptive history?”

## 2.) Ch. 2, V.11-15

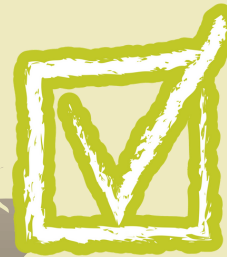
What is known about Moses's mindset in this circumstance? Is his retaliation upon his peoples' captors justified?
