- A virgin gave birth to a child...Do you believe it? Unbelievable Virgins don't give birth
- Tempted in every way...yet was sinless...Do you believe it? Unbelievable People aren't perfect
- Sight...blind Hearing...deaf Healing...lame...Do you believe it? It's unbelievable People can't
- Proclaimed He could forgive sin...Do you believe it? It's unbelievable A man can't forgive sin...
- Died on a cross taking God's wrath...Do you believe it? It's unbelievable A man can't take wrath
- Rose from the dead 3 days...do you believe it? It's unbelievable Men Don't come back death
- Ascended into Heaven...promise...do you believe it? It's unbelievable A man can't fix this world
 If Jesus is just a man...none of this should be believed | But what if this is true...

'Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign. Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call His name Immanuel (Which Means God with Us)'

If baby born in the manger is 'God with us' all should be believed... Point...Man can't - God can!

Christmas Reminds Us of God's Eternal Plan - Christmas Recognizes God's Eternal Purpose

Came to be 7000 miles & 2000 years away – Bethlehem – Animals – Ordinary – Caught world unaware

The Lord himself will give you a sign | Mary – Joseph – Shepherds

- People today certainly are looking for signs...especially around Christmas time
 - o Christmas movie Miracle on 34th St? Girl gets what she's always dreamed of a home
 - In the home is Santa's cane, the proof that he is real and he does care
- o Elf 'Best way to spread Christmas cheer is singing loud for all to hear' | Bonus | Hans Gruber We want a sign, confirmation...verse it's promised...not from Santa Claus or...lightning...wind tickle A virgin shall conceive and bear a son...Immanuel...God with us | Waiting for a sign...Manger!

That's why when the shepherds heard about it, the night was no longer a normal night in Bethlehem They were rejoicing, and tonight we rejoice: Big Idea - This Christmas Rejoice in God's Present Promise

- Prophecy fulfilled...night Bethlehem...shepherds got to see & rejoice over...not just shepherds
- Promise for us God's Promises Us His Presence Be with Him Implications are profound:
- 1. God's Present Promise: We're Accepted and Welcomed

One of the greatest things about Christmas is feeling welcomed...

- Fire is roaring Dinner is on the table Neil Diamond Christmas Family or friends are gathered
 Guest = Kicks the tree | Breaks the presents | Complains about the food | Lights the bathroom on fire
 Christmas Miracle God accepts & welcomes us...we're that guest! | Not our natural state!
- Because sin...separated...nothing we can do to find way to heaven...God's perfect eternal home
 God did what humanity couldn't Immanuel...came...came with a purpose of sacrificing for sinners
 The manger is the fulfillment of prophecy...star lit the way...manger sits in the shadow of the cross

Because Jesus came, not just to be born but to live and die, paying the penalty we deserved, we can now truly be welcome and accepted

More than just welcomed and accepted: Christmas also promises our guidance and protection

2. God's Present Promise: We're Guided and Protected

Belonging to the family of faith isn't just something that would happen later on in heaven He promised that he would continue to be with us here and now through the Holy Spirit

Isn't just a feeling...it's a truth - God is present in our lives, here, now, guiding & protecting In this verse in Isaiah, the term "son" doesn't just mean a kid

• It means the firstborn, which means the inheritor - The one to whom everything is owed

This means that if we have believed in Christ, we belong to Him

God cares for the things that are His

Since we belong to God, we can be completely confident that God cares deeply for us

- Hebrew culture...firstborn = inheritor Also the designated protector of the rest of the family
 - **God Protects the things that are His**
- Christmas = We're celebrating not only that we are welcome because of Christ
- But that we are guided and protected by his love and power every day = God with us!

Welcome Home – Christmas brought the Savior and the Savior brings us home

If Jesus is just a man...none of this should be believed

But if this is True...it's UNBELIEVABLE
