

Small-Group Discussion Questions

You can use these discussion questions to facilitate small groups after your sermon, or even create handouts for students to work through the message as you go. These questions are designed to help students have accountability in their walk with God and keep diving into the scriptures together.

1. How was the time and place you picked last week? Did it work for you?
2. What observations can you give us about what you read last week? Where are you reading in the Bible?
3. How did God speak to you through what you read? What verses stuck out? Why? What are the applications you took away?
4. What was your biggest struggle this past week finding time to read your Bible?
5. Did you pray before reading your Bible this week? Or during? If so, how did it help set your heart and mind before reading?
6. Are there any resources you use to help you have time with God? (Journal, bible, devotional, YouTube?)
7. After reading this week, what are some questions you have about the Bible?
