## Ice breaker questions:

What is, your favorite time of day? Favorite space outside (beach, mountains, lake, woods, backyard)? Favorite fruit or vegetable? Favorite time of day or year (night owl, morning person, spring, fall, summer, winter)? Favorite type of bird or fish? Favorite type of animal? Favorite person?

This may take a minute. However, it matches up with the order of creation in Genesis 1. Today's lesson is all about reminding our students and ourselves that God created a good world.

## Starting in scripture:

Then have someone pray for the room. Have everyone get an NIV bible. Read Genesis 1 together. Every time your group gets to the word good pause. Have everyone shout GOOD as loud as they can. Then at 1:31 shout very good.

How many times did we shout the word good? (6 times, plus very good once. 7 goods!)

Why do you think the author wrote the word good in Genesis 7 times? (Because God is good, God created a good world and God is working to bring it back).

Is it hard to see the world and people as good? Why? (Hallelujah, we have a big God who is in the restoration business).

**As we Go**, send one thing your thankful for in the group chat each day. Send one thing that is good to a friend. Pray to God daily and thank Him for all the good things in your life. Focus on what God is restoring and doing. Focus on what God has made good. Go out and do something good for someone. Focus on the Good.

**As we end**, everyone go around and say one thing that has been good from the previous week. Then let the last person say Amen.

**IF you have time:** check up on quiet times and scripture readings. Remembering that the whole Bible is the story of how God is restoring his people back to relationship with him in the garden. In the Garden, God walked daily with Adam and Eve. How are we walking with God daily?
