# The Message—Notes

### THE PRIORITY OF SACRIFICE

"A dinner was prepared in Jesus' honor. Martha served, and Lazarus was among those who ate with him. Then Mary took a twelve-ounce jar of expensive perfume made from essence of nard, and she anointed Jesus' feet with it, wiping his feet with her hair. The house was filled with the fragrance." ~ John 12:2-3 (NLT)

This Lazarus was the same man Jesus raised from the dead. It's not that hard to imagine why Mary would be motivated to take this expensive perfume and pour it on the feet of the man who had given her brother back to her from the grave.

We might be tempted to assume that Mary and her siblings were wealthy, so this act of reverence was not such a big deal. However, consider that the perfume Mary lovingly poured out was worth an entire year's wages for an ordinary worker. I know there are very rich people who can do extravagant things, but there is nothing in the Bible that suggests Mary was that well off. When Jesus came to visit, Mary and her sister had to prepare the meal, something that servants would do for the extremely wealthy of that time. Others have suggested the perfume was a gift to Mary from some rich acquaintance. Even if that were so, she took a very valuable gift and used it extravagantly.

Based on what we know, I must conclude that Mary's act of worship represented a real sacrifice. She gave up something of great value to her, so that she could make much of Jesus. This is consistent with the pattern we see throughout the Bible. People who really love God sacrifice for Him, not to win His favor or earn salvation, but in response to His generous grace given to us.

Paul urges us to "offer up your bodies to Him while you are still alive" (Romans 12:1). He goes on to say, "Your bodies are a holy sacrifice that is pleasing to God." As we enjoy the unearned grace God pours into our lives, let's not be ungrateful, but rather let's remember the priority of sacrifice in response to what God has done for us.


