The Message—Notes

THE PRIORITY OF WORSHIP

"Let us go to the sanctuary of the Lord; let us worship at the footstool of his throne. Arise, O Lord, and enter your resting place, along with the Ark, the symbol of your power. May your priests be clothed in godliness; may your loyal servants sing for joy." ~ Psalm 132:7-9 (NLT)

In the Old Testament times, God's glory was physically present above the mercy seat on the top of the Ark of the Covenant. The Ark was housed in a special inner room in the Tabernacle (a portable temple) and later in the permanent temple in Jerusalem. The Ark and the temple around it were tended by the priests who were descended from a specific family.

After Jesus died on the cross and rose from the dead, He became the new eternal High Priest and He makes everyone who finds salvation in Him priests. So, without being overly theologically rigorous, this passage from Psalms could read, "May [your name here] be clothed in godliness; may your loyal servants sing for joy."

All through the Bible we see the priority of worship for God's people. We can't claim to love Him and not worship Him. We can't truly know Him and not worship Him. Worship is the default response to being in God's presence. As church-age believers, His presence is always with us.

Worship is also a battle. The enemy knows how important worship is in keeping us from backsliding in our walk with God, so he will do everything in his power to keep your worship focused on anything or anyone except Jesus. I know how difficult it is to cultivate a worshipful attitude, especially when our singing is being lead by videos. It's easy to forget that we don't give attention to those on stage out of respect for them, but out of respect for the God they are leading us to worship. We don't clap for them; we clap for Him.

So, today I encourage you to focus on what you know of God's glory as you sing along or listen meditatively to the songs. Pray along in your heart with the prayers lead from the stage. Seek to know more of God from the message shared. And fight to keep worship your priority!


