Philippians 2:9-11

[9] Therefore ^{father} God ^{“hyperypsoō”} has highly exalted ^{Son} him

conj. *only time in NT* *Super-exalted* *To exalt to the highest position/rank/power* *Hyper*

and bestowed ^{Son} on him ^{def.} the name ^{prep.} that is above every name, ^{adj.} *“LORD”*

give graciously *give freely* *★ Pleasure ★*

[10] so that at the name ^{“pas”} of Jesus every knee should bow,

conj. *prep.* *def.* *Bend* *Kneel*

in heaven and on earth and under the earth,

adjective *conj.* *adjective* *adjective*

★ heavenly ★ *★ earthly ★* *★ Under-earthly ★*

★ Souls departed to heaven and souls sentenced to hell will be reunited with their bodies so that all who have ever existed will at the same time bend the knee to the exalted Christ. ★

[11] and every tongue confess that ^{“pas”} Jesus Christ ^{“kyrios”} is Lord,

conj. *adj.* *profess* *acknowledge* *conj.*

to the glory ^{“doxa”} of God ^{“pater”} the Father.

prep. *Slendor* *Magesty* *Brightness* *★ Ascribed ★*

DOCTRINE. Because Christ humbled Himself to the lowest of lows to redeem, the Father has exalted Him to reign.
