THE IMMORTAL GOD ROMANS 1:16-22 | BRO. JACOB MUDD

- The Main Point: Since God is plain to all men and He has determined Jesus as the only way to be made right with Him, believers in Jesus have a desperate responsibility to proclaim His message to all men for the sake of His global glory.
- Point 1: The Gospel is something to be proud of.
 - The Gospel: the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also the Greek.
 - The power of God is the Gospel and results in salvation for all believers.
 - <u>Righteousness of God</u>: all of God's positive attributes. All His goodness.
- Point 2: The Wrath of God.
- Point 3: There is hope.
