

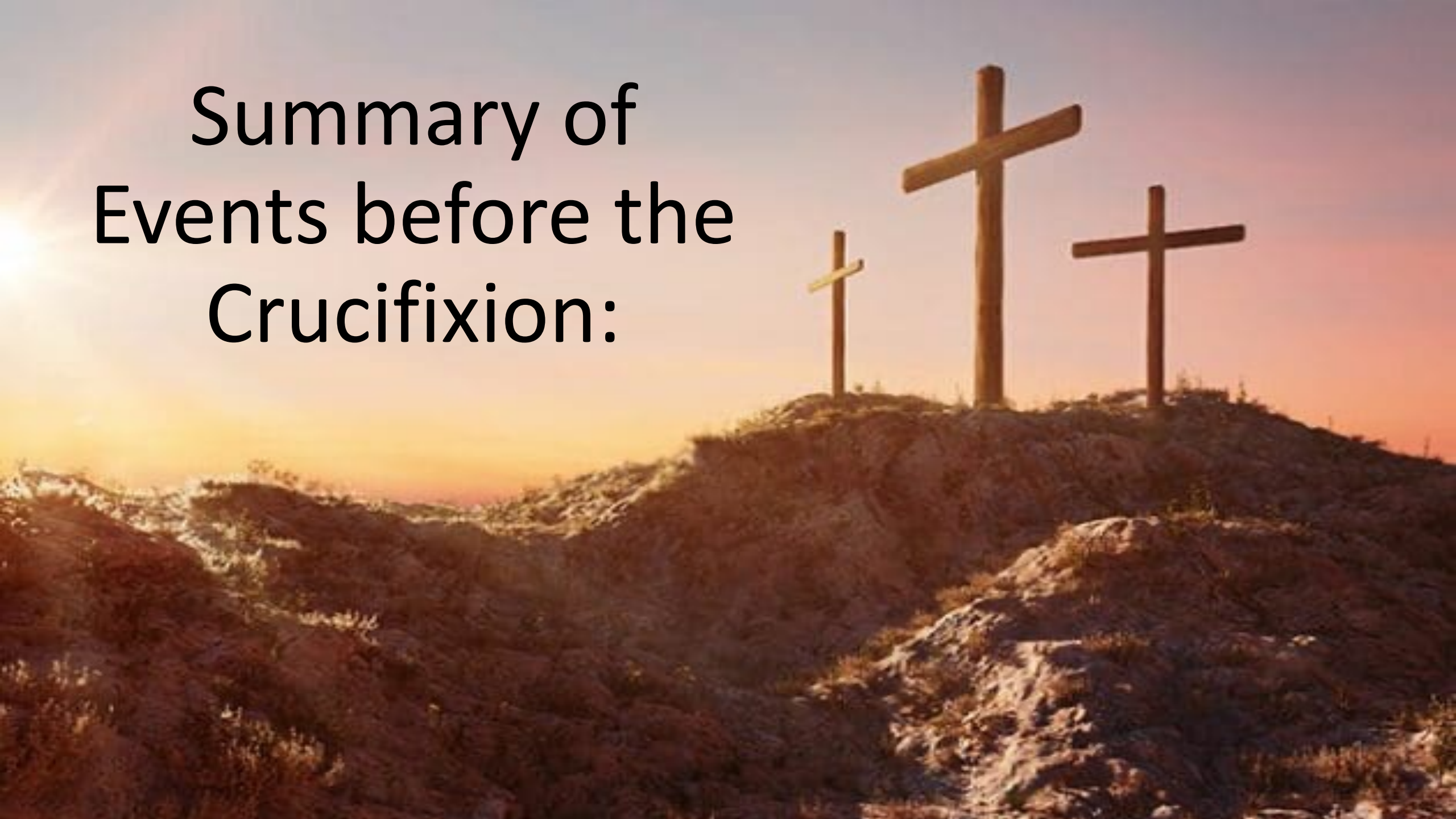


# The Crucifixion/Resurrection— A Prophetic Perspective

# Jews mocked Jesus



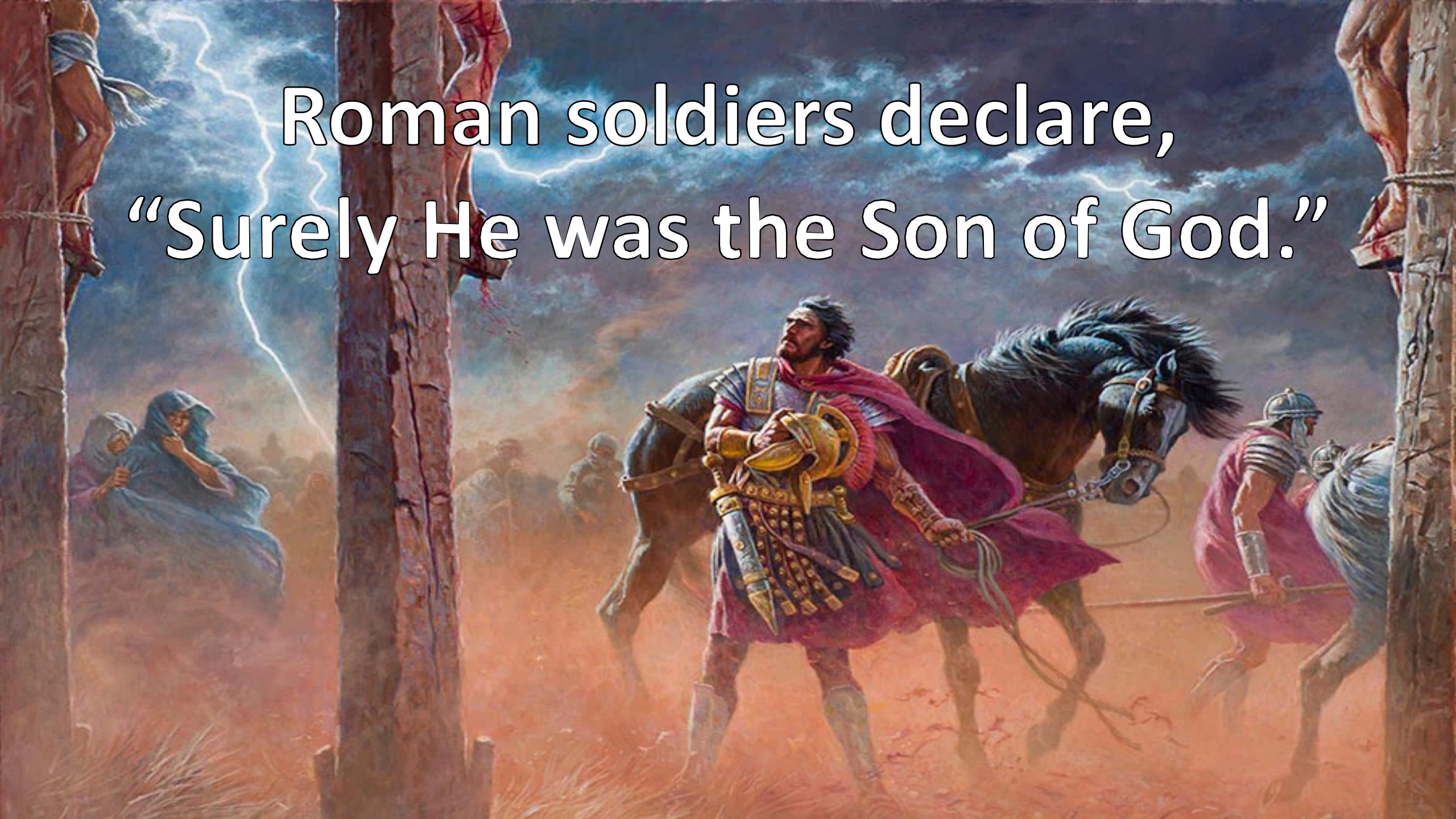

“I am a worm”

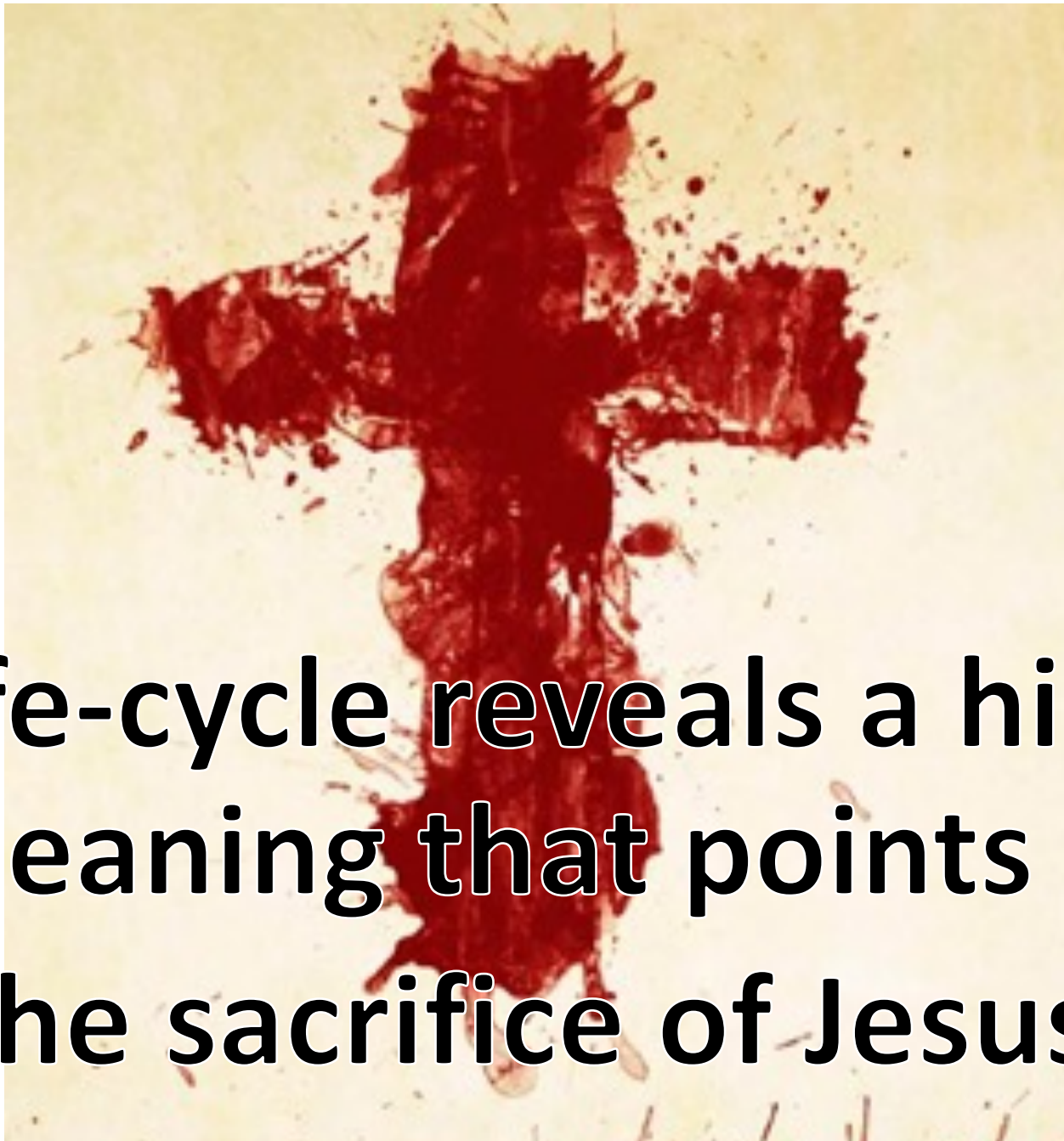


## Psalm 22:6

The Hebrew word  
translated  
worm is tolav.  
It is a crimson  
grub.



**Its life-cycle reveals a hidden meaning that points to the sacrifice of Jesus.**



Just as the mother worm attaches herself to the tree or fence, Jesus willingly allowed himself to be hung on a tree or cross.



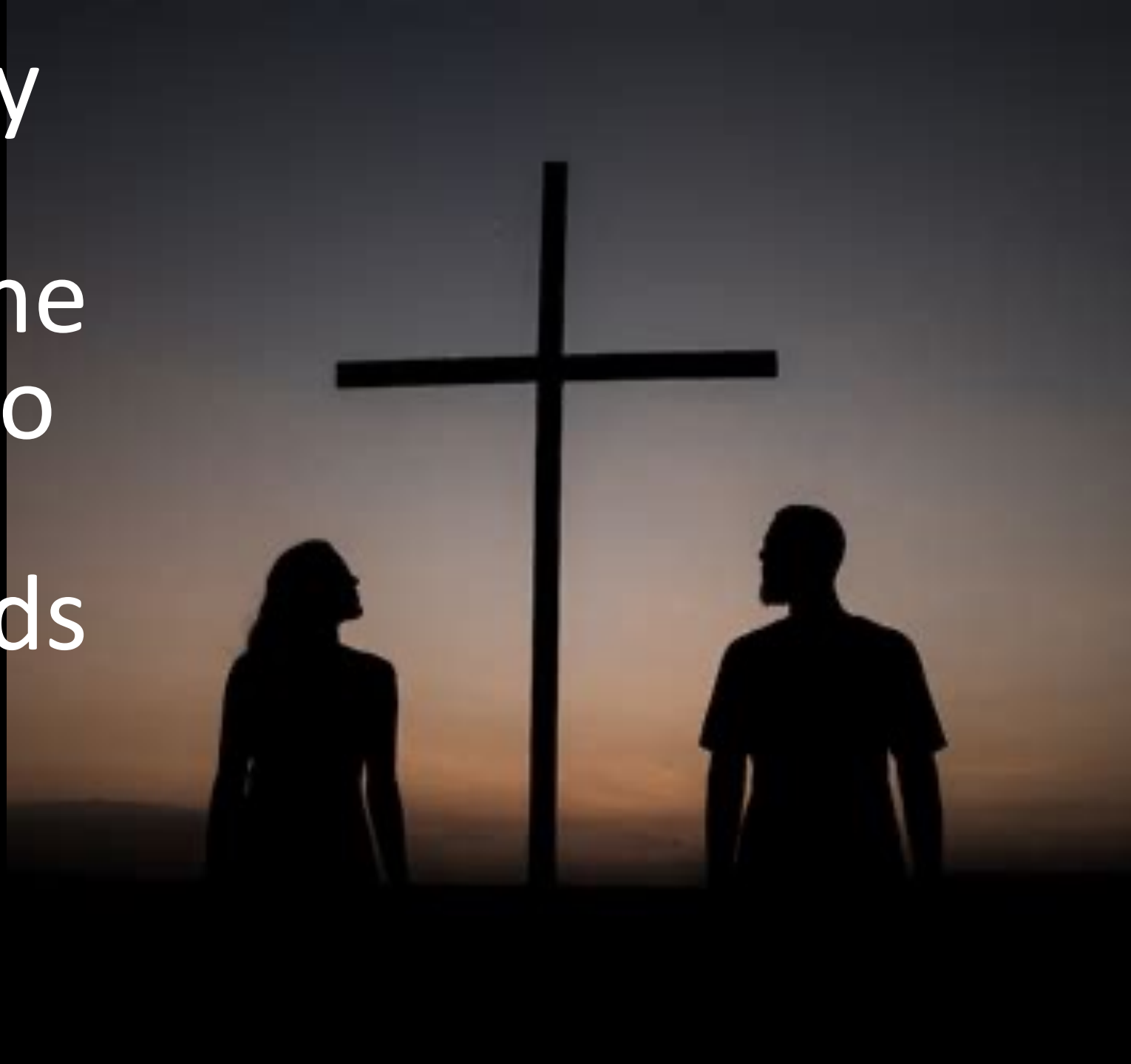


Just as the mother worm, when crushed, excretes a scarlet dye that covers the baby worms and stains them, Jesus was bruised for our iniquities.



Just as the baby worm is dependent on the mother worm for the crimson dye to mark it, a Christian depends on the blood of Jesus for the forgiveness of sins, to receive new life and be marked as His own.
