

What is It?

Acts is a continuation of the Gospel of Luke. Often called the "Acts of the Apostles", a more appropriate title may be "Acts of the Holy Spirit". Originally, it's believed that Luke and Acts were a single work which was split sometime in the 1st or 2nd century AD. It's the third longest book in the NT, and with Luke comprises 30% of the Testament.

Who, What, When, Where and Why

Who – Acts was written by Luke of whom it is thought that he was a Gentile physician. He was a loyal friend and sometime companion of Paul.

What – Acts records the work done by the Holy Spirit through Jesus' followers and the Church. Peter and Paul are the predominate individuals, but others are significant as well. It's the story of what Jesus said as recorded in Acts 1:8 "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samria, and to the end of the earth." This is how the Word spread and continues to spread. The results of His work, are astounding; the Church "mushroomed" in growth.

When –Based on historical events not included in the text, it's believed to have been written sometime around 64 A.D.; before the fall of Jerusalem (70 A.D.).

Where – It's believed that Luke wrote Acts while in Rome with Paul.

Why – Luke wrote the Gospel and Acts to inform and instruct Theophilus and others with "certainty" (Luke 1:4) of Jesus' redemptive work and those of His followers post Jesus's ascension through the efforts of the Holy Spirit.

Reading Advice

To read the 28 chapters of Acts this week, depending on the number of days, you will need to read 5-7 chapters a day. While reading, note the work of the Holy Spirit in each chapter. He is noted 70 times in Acts, more than any other book. The following schedule is suggested.
