


BUILDING A FOUNDATION

Deuteronomy 6:4-9 (continued)

You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.


DEUT 6:4-9: THE SHEMA

 How would your children or grandchildren describe your home? Don't have kids yet? How would you like your future children to describe your home?


- What do others see in your family when they visit your home? Do you even have visitors in your home?

Joyful: 51%

Nurturing: 38%

These are how Christians described their homes.


It's the routines, activities and relationships that create the atmosphere.

What kind of atmosphere permeates your household?

Abiding is about a relationship with another, but so much more. It's also about communication, trust, mutual respect, shared experiences – all leading to a deep, enduring, long-lasting connection.

But what does it take to make a **Spiritually Vibrant** Household?



But what does it take to make a **Spiritually Vibrant** Household?

I have close friends in my life who feel like family: 91%

I personally pray to God: 80%

I personally read from the Bible in the past week: 76%

A household member talks with me about God's forgiveness: 76%

A household member sets an example: 73%

A household member teaches me about the Bible: 73%

A household member encourages me to go to church: 71%

A household member teaches me about traditions: 69%

We have household meetings: 68%



But what does it take to make a **Spiritually Vibrant** Household?

We share how we're feeling with each other daily: 59%

I pray with friends who visit: 58%

A close friend visits on a regular basis: 56%

I have deep conversations with close friends: 55%

We go on walks monthly: 55%

I personally attended religious small group or Bible study in the past week: 51%

We go to the park monthly: 48%

I have close friends over for dinner: 44%



But what does it take to make a **Spiritually Vibrant** Household?

- Members have a personal spirituality
- Spends fun, quality time together
- A spiritual coach is present
- Welcomes others
- Asks for help

The Significant of the Mundane

Do the Math

Parents have approximately 3.000 hours in a given year to influence the heart and life of their child.


In comparison, church leaders have approximately 40-52 hours with a child each year.



THE SPIRITUALLY VIBRANT HOUSEHOLD

WHAT IS A SPIRITUALLY VIBRANT HOUSEHOLD?

From the patterns found in the LHM/Barna survey, some conclusions about what makes a spiritually vibrant household emerges:

- Individual members have a personal spirituality
- The family spends quality time together they do fun things together
- There is at least one spiritual coach/leader in the family
- The household welcomes others into its fold
- The members of the households can ask and offer help to each other

LHM/Barna and Don Everts, *The Spiritually Vibrant Home* (the book we have used primarily so far) – organize these household characteristics into three concepts:

- Messy Prayers
- Loud Tables
- Open Doors

More on these concepts coming up, so be thinking about them. Also think about potential threats to a vibrant and spiritually vibrant household.
