The Lutheran Church Missouri Synod LCMS

- Originally called *The German Evangelical Lutheran Synod of Missouri, Ohio and other States*. April 1847
- Originally made up of 14 congregations and 12 pastors from Illinois, Indiana, Missouri, Michigan, New York and Ohio.
- C.F.W.(Carl Ferdinand Wilhelm) Walther is 1st President.
- At the 100th anniversary, 1947, name changed to LCMS

The Lutheran Church Missouri Synod LCMS

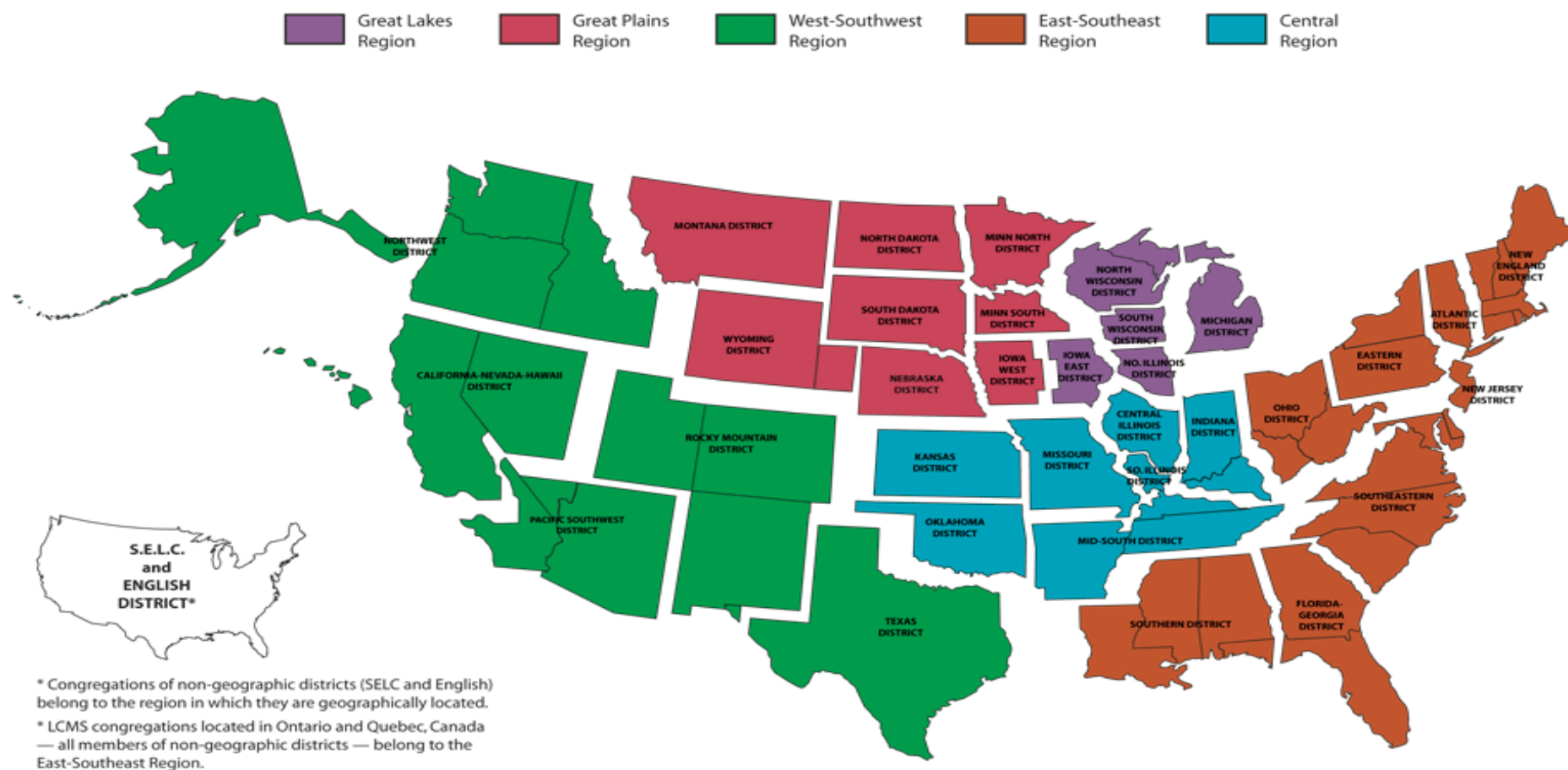
- Headquarters in St. Louis, Missouri.
- 6 Universities with 7 residential campuses – California, Illinois, Michigan, Minnesota, Nebraska, Texas, and Wisconsin
- 2 Seminaries – Concordia Theological Seminary Fort Wayne, Indiana and Concordia Seminary St. Louis, Missouri.
- 33 Geographical and 2 non geographical Districts in US and Canada.

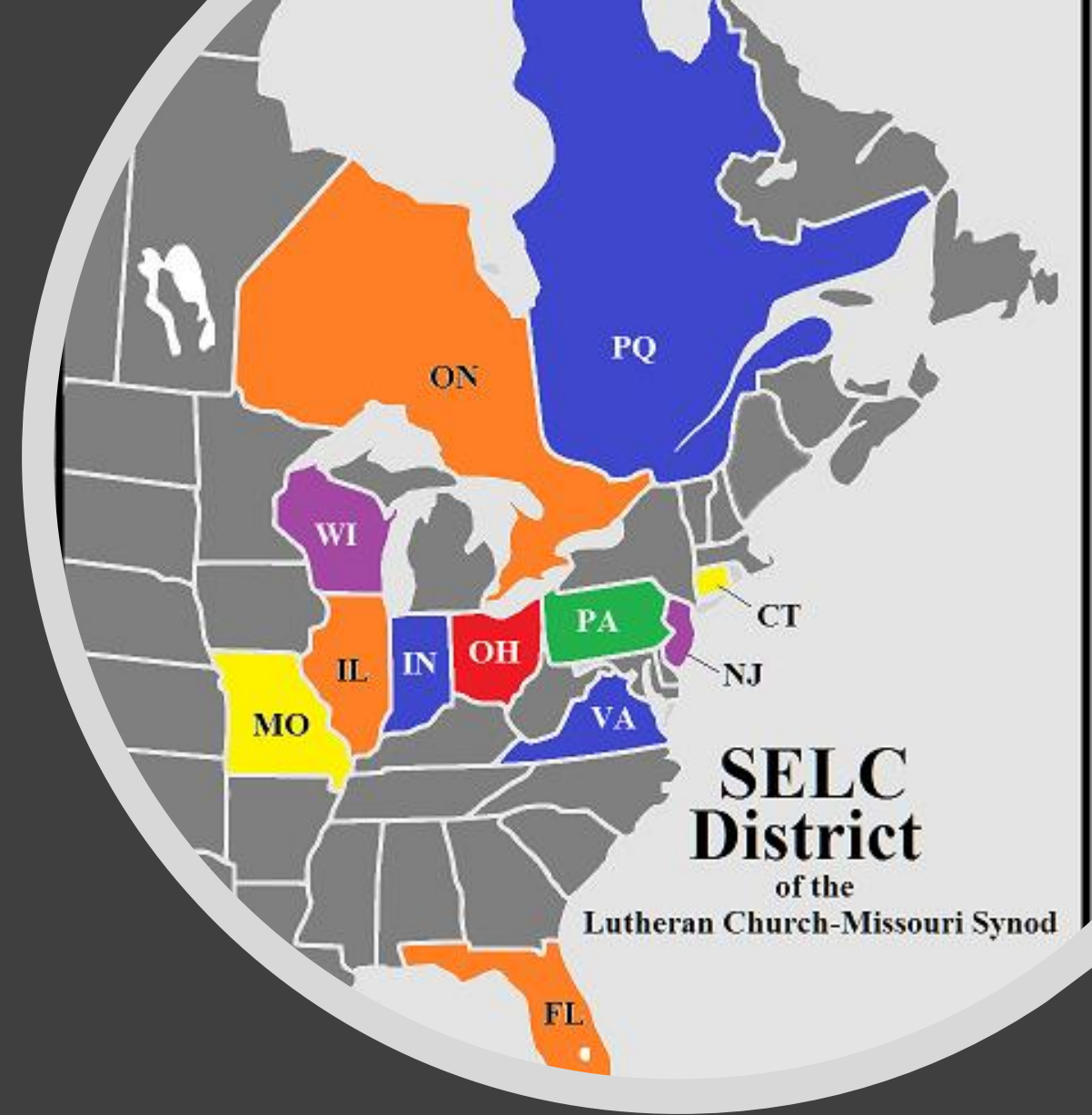
