Eliab was attacking David rather than Goliath. "We need to choose our battles wisely. If you don't watch it, all of your battles will be fought among fellow members of the family of God. Meanwhile, the real enemy of our souls roams around our territory winning victory after victory." Chuck Swindoll 3. ... we underestimate God's work through \_\_\_\_\_\_. Saul: We doubt what God can do in others.
