To Kill the "Cannibal" of Contentment I Will Accept that...

1. I brought nothing in and I can take nothing out of this world.

"For we brought nothing into the world, and we cannot take anything out of the world." Vs. 7

"Naked I came from my mother's womb, and naked shall I return."

Godliness is gain!

"But godliness with contentment is great gain." Vs. 6

"I have learned in whatever situation I am to be content."

• Greed is loss!

"But those who desire to be rich fall into temptation, into a snare, into many senseless and harmful desires that plunge people into ruin and destruction." Vs. 9

2. I can effectively pursue only one craving at a time.
