To Win the Battle for My Mind...

1. I must understand the type of war I'm fighting!

"For though we walk in the flesh, we are not waging war according to the flesh." Vs. 3

2. I must train using God's ancient weapons of war!

3. I must battle against the strongholds in my life!

"We destroy arguments and every lofty opinion raised against the knowledge of God." Vs. 5a

Learn to think like Jesus.

"For who has understood the mind of the Lord so as to instruct Him? But we have the mind of Christ." 1 Corinthians 2:16

• Choose your ways rather than the ways of this world.

"Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind." Romans 12:2a

Reject double-minded thinking as I walk with you.

Use the Bible to combat the strategies of the enemy.
