If I am to Find True Rest...

I. I will benefit from the mistakes of those who failed to enter the Promised Land!

"Let us therefore strive to enter that rest, so that no one may fall by the same sort of disobedience." Vs. 11

"For good news came to us just as to them, but the message (logos) they heard did not benefit them, because they were not united by faith with those who listened." Vs. 2

Guaranteed Recipe for Failure:

To know the Word of God and choose to do otherwise!

• Is my most effective guide to the Promised Land.
