### <u>Truths to Remember when Living Behind Enemy Lines...</u>

#### I. I must embrace the total sovereignty of God!

"In the third year of the reign of Jehoiakim king of Judah,
Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came to Jerusalem and besieged it.
And the Lord gave Jehoiakim king of Judah into his hand, with some of

605 BC	Jerusalem besieged by Nebuchadnezzar; Daniel and his 3 friends taken <i>Behind Enemy Lines</i> into Babylon.
602 BC	Daniel and his 3 friends complete their 3 year training <i>Behind Enemy Lines</i> ; Daniel explains Nebuchadnezzar's dream.
597 BC	Babylonians attack Jerusalem again.
586 BC	Jerusalem and the temple destroyed by Nebuchadnezzar.
539 BC	Belshazzar's feast and the handwriting on the wall.
537 BC	About 50,000 Jews return, led by Zerubbabel and Joshua the high priest. Daniel has his prophetic vision about the
