To Lead Others Upwards in Christ...

I. I will be shackled to my Lord above all else! "I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord...." Vs. 1a

II. I will value properly my call to salvation!

"...urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called." Vs. 1b

<u>"Church"</u> = *Ecclesia* – the "called-out" ones.

"I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus." Philippians 3:14

III. I will build up Christian unity among God's people

5 Ways to Strengthen Christian Unity in the Church:

1. By modeling true humility as a lifestyle. *"…with all humility."* Vs. 2a

- **2.** By striving for gentleness in my dealings with others. *"…with all humility and gentleness."* Vs. 2b
- **3. By patiently enduring whatever comes as I serve the Lord.** *"…with all humility and gentleness, with patience."* Vs. 2c
- **4.** By loving my Christian family like Jesus loves me. "...with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with

one another in love." Vs. 2d

5. By planting seeds of peace in all my relationships.

"...eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace." Vs. 3
