While the world values highly the glitz and glamour of success, God values highly the grit and grind of faithfulness!

I Expect My Pastoral Leadership to Develop...

1. Callouses as a servant of Christ Jesus!

"This is how one should regard us, as servants of Christ." Vs. 1a

A Faithful Servant of Christ Jesus...

- Finds his identity in Jesus above all else.
- Joyfully embraces his position as a slave to his Master.
- Reflects humility in keeping with his lowly position.

2. Wisdom as a steward of the mysteries of God!

"...and stewards of the mysteries of God." Vs. 1b

"For an overseer, as God's steward, must be above reproach." Titus 1:7

3. Sweat stains as a faithful worker for the Kingdom! "Moreover, it is required of stewards that they be found faithful." Vs. 2

Faithfulness is...

• Recognizing the gifts God has blessed me with!

"For it will be like a man going on a journey, who called his servants and entrusted to them his property. To one he gave five talents, to another two, to another one, to each according to his ability." Matthew 25:14-15

- Obediently putting the gifts to work for His glory! See Matthew 25:16-18
- Earning a full return on God's investment in me! See Matthew 25:19-20, 22
- Finishing the job to hear two words, "Well done!" "His master said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over a little; I will set you over much. Enter into the joy of your master." Matthew 25:21
