"Take care, brothers, lest there be in any of you an evil, unbelieving heart, leading you to fall away from the living God." Vs. 12

I am in Danger of an Unbelieving Heart when...

1) My heart is hardened to the voice of God.

"Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says, 'Today, if you hear His voice, do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion."" Vs. 7-8a

2) My faith fails when I'm being tested.

"...on the day of testing in the wilderness." Vs. 8b

3) My unbelief remains after seeing God at work.

"...where your father put me to the test and saw my works for forty years." Vs. 9

4) My contempt grows the harder my heart becomes.

"And the LORD said to Moses, 'How long will this people despise me? And how long will they not believe in me, in spite of all the signs that I have done among them?" Numbers 14:11

5) My grumbling and complaining about God increases.

"Therefore the people quarreled with Moses ... and the people grumbled against Moses." Exodus 17:2, 3

6) My willingness to persevere diminishes.

"For we have come to share in Christ, if indeed we hold our original confidence firm to the end." Vs. 14

7) My failure to live my spiritual destiny is obvious.
