The Gospel and Religious Freedom...

I. Recognizes that this is my Father's world!

"So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them." Genesis 1:27

"The earth is the LORD's and the fullness thereof, the world and those who dwell therein." Psalm 24:1

Religious freedom is a right granted by God to every individual at creation!

II. Understands that God establishes all governing authorities in His world!

"Let every person be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those that exist have been instituted by God." Romans 13:1

My religious freedom stands above every earthly authority in this world!

III. Demands that I exercise my religious freedom in His world!

"But during the night an angel of the Lord opened the prison doors and brought them out, and said, 'Go and stand in the temple and speak to the people all the words of this Life.' And when they heard this, they entered the temple at daybreak and began to teach." Acts 5:19-21

"Jesus said to them, 'Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's." Mark 12:17
