Hebrews 4:14-16 & Selected

Jesus is greater than any challenge or problem I will face in 2017 – if I will just believe it and live it!

Why is Jesus Greater?

I. Because He alone is my Great High Priest!

"Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God." Vs. 14a

"Consequently, He is able to save to the uttermost those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them."
