"I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus." Philippians 3:14

I must never be satisfied...

I. Because I have not reached the finish line yet.

"Not that I have already obtained all this, or have been made perfect."

Vs. 12a

"Do you not know that in a race all the runners run, but only one receives the prize? So run that you may obtain it." 1 Corinthians 9:24

II. Because I have been bought at a very high price.

"Not that I have already obtained all this, or have been made perfect, but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me His own." Vs. 12

"You are not your own, for you were bought with a price."

1 Corinthians 6:19b-20a

III. Because the goal demands my continuous effort.

"...but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me." Vs. 12

"Consider Him who endured such opposition from sinful men, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart." Hebrews 12:3

Jesus said, "If anyone would come after Me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow Me." Matthew 16:24

IV. Because God calls me to focus my eyes on Him.

"Brothers, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on." Vs. 13-14a

The Importance of Focused Living...

"I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus." Vs. 14

- Beware of obstacles that block your path.
- Allow "holy discontent" to set your pace.
- Forget the pain of failures in your past.
- Allow God to refresh you as you run for the prize.

V. Because Jesus is worthy of my total effort!

"Only let us live up to what we have already attained." Vs. 16
