

Reflection Questions March 31, 2024 Easter 2024 – All Things New Revelation 21:5-8

"Behold, I make all things new..." What is the significance of the resurrection of Jesus Christ and what does it means for humanity? Human history is full of attempts to find fulfillment and harmony in a world without God, but they all end in futility. The truth is, only through faith in Jesus and being made new by Him can one be ready for the harmonious new creation and eternal life.

Reflection Questions:

- 1. In what ways do we as humans try to recreate Eden without God?
- 2. Why is it important to recognize that man cannot create harmony in the world or within themselves?
- 3. How does the resurrection of Jesus provide proof that there is someone who can bring about renewal and make all things new?
- 4. Why is the concept of a new creation only half of the story, and what other important aspect must be considered?
- 5. What does it mean to be made new by faith in Christ, and how does this prepare us for the new creation?
- 6. How does the list of offenses mentioned in verse 8 of Revelation 21 reveal the need for a new heart?
- 7. What is the significance of God's promise to complete the good work in us and bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ?
- 8. How does the idea of having our names written in the Lamb's book of life impact our understanding of salvation and preparation for the new creation?
