

Reflection Questions September 10, 2023 Fear Not, Stand Firm, See, and Be Silent Exodus 13:17-14:14

God leads Israel in a way that may seem unconventional, but He knows what they can handle and what's best for them. It's a reminder that God's leadership may not always align with our logic, and faith is crucial.

Reflection Questions:

- 1. Can you think of a time in your life when you had to trust someone's guidance even though it didn't make immediate sense? How did it turn out?
- 2. What do you think it means that God decreed all things? (See Ephesians 1:11, Proverbs 16:4, Acts 2:23; 4:27-28)
- 3. What does God's decree imply about our struggles on the difficult road of faith?
- 4. What is the biggest problem all human beings face? Why should this be the main concern of our lives?
- 5. How can you apply the lesson from the Israelites' journey to your own life? Are there areas where you need to trust God's guidance more?
- 7. What are some ways to remind ourselves to trust God's leadership when we face challenges or uncertainty?
- 8. Israel had God's presence with them in the pillar of cloud and fire. How do believers in Christ have even better comfort than this?
- 9. How can God's presence provide comfort and assurance in your life today?

Prayer Points:

- 1. Ask God to help you trust Him more, even when it doesn't seem He's at work.
- 2. Ask God to help you keep your eyes on Jesus.
- 3. Ask God for discernment to recognize His hand in your life.
- 4. Ask God for a spirit that is willing to follow Him even when you don't understand His purpose.
- 5. Praise God for His faithfulness.
