The Book of the Covenant – Part 3

Exodus 23:1-13

This week, we look at the importance of truth, justice, and mercy, as well as the call to live consecrated lives where there is no divide between sacred and secular. Highlighting the Christian call to seek the truth, pursue justice, and show mercy to others.

Reflection Questions:

1. How does the concept of truth, justice, and mercy intertwine with our understanding of God's character?
2. What are some practical ways we can apply the principles of truth and justice in our daily lives, especially when faced with situations of gossip or false reports?
3. How do you see the relationship between standing for truth and justice and being disliked or facing opposition from the world?
4. How can we show mercy to those who doubt or hold different views than us, even when it may be challenging or against our natural inclinations?
5. What does it mean to have a rhythm of work and rest in our lives, and how can we ensure we prioritize rest and refreshment in a world filled with busyness and demands?
6. How can we reflect the heart of God by extending mercy and care to those who may be outsiders, foreigners, or experiencing hardship?
7. How can we avoid falling in with the majority and instead turn to seeking the truth and weighing the facts, even when it goes against popular beliefs or narratives?
8. How can our faith in God's truth, justice, and mercy shape our involvement in moral issues and discussions in our culture?
9. Reflecting on the promise of eternal Sabbath rest, how can we find hope and encouragement in the midst of the struggles and tribulations of this world?
