

Reflection Questions November 19, 2023 A Family Gathering Exodus 18:1-12

Moses is reunited with his father-in-law, Jethro. As we approach the holiday season and gather with our own families, there are valuable lessons to be learned from Moses' example. How can this passage serve as a reminder for us to approach our family gatherings as opportunities to glorify God and share His love with those who may not know Him?

Reflection Questions:

- 1. How do you typically approach family gatherings during the holiday season? Do you view them as opportunities to share your faith or simply as social events?
- 2. Reflecting on Moses' example, how can you honor and respect your extended family members during these gatherings?
- 3. How can you incorporate conversations about salvation into your interactions with unsaved loved ones without coming across as pushy or judgmental?
- 4. Discuss the importance of acknowledging both the blessings and hardships that come from following Christ when sharing your faith.
- 5. Have you ever experienced resistance or negative reactions from family members when discussing matters of faith? How did you handle those situations?
- 6. In what ways can we demonstrate Christ-like love and grace towards difficult or challenging family members during these gatherings?
- 7. What practical steps can we take to ensure that our actions align with our words when it comes to sharing our faith with our families?
