## **Reflection Questions:**

- 1. How does the design of the Golden Lampstand reflect the nature of God's presence in the Tabernacle?
- 2. Why is the lampstand being the only source of light in the Tabernacle significant in understanding the function of light in worship?
- 3. In what ways does the lampstand's tree-like design and the use of pure gold enhance our understanding of its symbolic meaning?
- 4. Discuss the relationship between the physical light provided by the lampstand and the spiritual light represented by God's Word.
- 5. How does the lampstand illuminate the essential roles and functions within the Holy Place of the Tabernacle?
- 6. Why is it important that the lampstand was made from one solid piece of gold, and what might this suggest about the continuity and unity of God's Word?
- 7. What does the light of the lampstand tell us about God's intentions for interaction and fellowship with His people?
- 8. Reflect on the connection between the lampstand in the Tabernacle and Jesus being the Light of the World. How does this enhance your understanding of Christ's role in salvation history?
- 9. Discuss the connection between the seven lights of the lampstand, and the seven lampstands in Revelation 1:20.
